For and against essays consist of three parts:

1. Opening

2. Body

3. Conclusion

1. Opening

2. Body

- The body in a for and against essay has two parts.
 1. In the first part the writer presents the side he or she disagrees with
 2. In the second part the writer presents the side he or she agrees with

The two parts normally consist of one paragraph each, but they can also consist of more.

3. Conclusion

In the conclusion of a for and against essay the writer gives his or her opinion

TITLE:

Taking a gap year; pros and cons.

1. Opening

In this part we introduce the issue

You can be considering taking a “gap year” between secondary school and university . It is possible you are considering this in order to work, travel or volunteer in another country. However, before you decide, consider the pros and cons.
