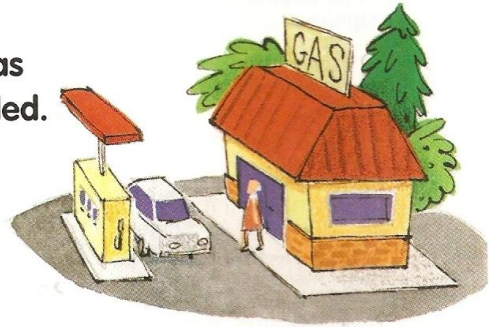


D. Write each sentence. Add commas where they are needed.
